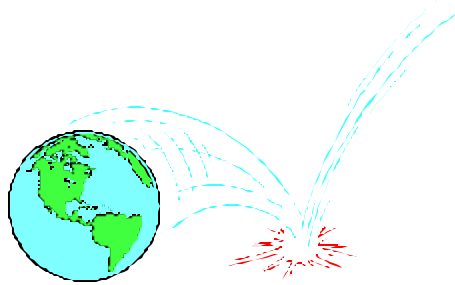


Colorado Lamplighter's Endowment

The Colorado Lamplighter's Endowment was established by the Lamplighters of the Colorado State Council of ESA International in 1999. The specific criterion is for a student from Colorado attending any college with any major. This endowment is not endowed at this time.

Judging Criteria B: This scholarship is weighted to Financial Need: Scoring 100 points, the distribution is 10 points for Character, 10 points for Leadership, 5 points for Service, 50 points for Financial need, and 25 points Scholastic Ability.
